- **YAGONG DOES NOT** support building a heavy industrial Veneer Mill Co-generation power plant in the middle of the O'okala Residential Community. Despite the **OVERWHELMING PLEA** by the majority of the O'okala residents, **HOLSCHUH CHOOSES** to go against the wishes of the people, and **SUPPORTS THE MILL** in the proposed O'okala site. **YAGONG SUPPORTS** building a veneer mill in an appropriate location, however, **NOT IN ANY RESIDENTIAL COMMUNITY**. There is enough land away from residential areas to get this accomplished. The **QUALITY OF LIFE** must be protected and sustained for families living in a residential community. **YAGONG WILL** stand up for your community.

- **YAGONG SUPPORTS** setting aside 2% of real property taxes to purchase precious open space and natural resources for future generations. **HOLSCHUH VOTED AGAINST** the 2% initiative. Mayor Kim submitted setting aside \$3 million dollars in the preservation fund in this years operating budget. **HOLSCHUH VOTED TO SHIFT \$2 MILLION OUT OF THE PRESERVATION FUND**, and spent the money elsewhere. We need leadership that has vision and understanding of how important preservation of open space is to future generations.

- **YAGONG BELIEVES** you need to be a **LEADER** while serving on the Hawaii County Council. **YAGONG** was selected by his Council peers to be **CHAIRMAN** of significant budget committees. **YAGONG CHAIRED** the Public Works & Parks and Recreation Committee, the Environmental Management Committee, and was Vice-Chair of the Economic Development Committee. In his two terms on the Council, **HOLSCHUH'S** only leadership role has been Chairman of the **HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE**. This working group is the lowest budgeted committee (\$900,000) on the County Council. That is less then .3% of the \$326 million dollar operating budget.
